


Systemic Litigation and Advocacy



- 1975 Developmental Disabilities Assistance and Bill of Rights Act includes Protection & Advocacy
- 1977 Planning grants to State (\$20,000)
  - 1978 Protection & Advocacy agencies begin operations with State Designations








 1984 – Client Assistant Program (CAP) reauthorized as formula grant program



- 1986 Protection & Advocacy for Mentally III Individuals (PAIMI) program enacted (Institutions + 90 days)
- 2001 Expansion of PAIMI to community





• 1989 – Protection & Advocacy for Individuals Rights (PAIR) demos

- 1991 PAIR program reauthorized to formula grant
  - 1993 PAIR trigger reached




- 2009 Henry's Turkey Farm Expose
